The Limitations of the World Under the Sun

- There is nothing new under the sun (Ecclesiastes 1:9).
- Solomon experienced and witnessed this truth.

The Need for a Change of Atmosphere

- As children of the light, we need a change of atmosphere.
- We are living in a dark and strange hour, desperate for a change.

Defining Atmosphere

- Scientifically: a shift in the Earth's atmospheric conditions, such as temperature, air pressure, or gas composition.
- Spiritually: a shift in the spiritual realm, affecting our ability to breathe spiritually.

The Spiritual Atmosphere

- The air pressure in the spiritual realm has become toxic.
- The Prince of the Air has filled the cup of iniquity to the brim.
- Jesus' words are being fulfilled: *iniquity shall increase, and many hearts shall grow cold* (Matthew 24:12).

The Signs of the Times

- Jesus foretold that one of the signs of His coming would be the growing coldness of many hearts as iniquity increases.
- The spiritual temperature and weather have become freezing cold.

The Power to Change the Spiritual Weather

- Elijah was able to discern that the rain would come, and he told Ahab to go and see.
- We must believe in the power of the One who controls our spiritual weather.

The Pollution of the World

- There is much pollution in the spiritual weather, making it easy to be filled with corruption.
- One little peek outside can cause us to fall into sin.

The Heated Furnace of the World

- The things of the world have become like a heated furnace, heated seven times more in this seventh church age.
- Blessed be the name of the Lord who makes His grace abound the more for us who believe.

The Change of Atmosphere

- We desire a change of atmosphere, and it gives us this change in the atmosphere.
- *In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye*, He is able to change the way we see things. He changes the darkest areas of our lives to become light.

The Emotional Atmosphere

- The word “atmosphere” can also be defined emotionally as a noticeable shift in our mood or feeling concerning a certain situation.
- Example: hearing news of a school shooting can quickly shift our emotional atmosphere.

Keeping Calm in the Storm

- We each have an emotional atmosphere surrounding us that is able to shift our mood and feelings by any given situation.
- But as children of the light, love should be filling our hearts, knowing that all things are working together for our good.

The Example of the Shunammite Woman

- She lost her son, but when asked if all was well, she said, “*Amen. Yes, all is well.*”
- She remained emotionally sound and knew where to go for help, to Elisha. We also know where to go, for a greater than Elisha is here!
- The Lord changed the atmosphere of death to one of peace.

The Words of Jesus

- “*Come to me all you that are heavy and burdened, and I will give you rest*” (Matthew 11:28).
- These words have the power to change the atmosphere of any given situation.

Arising from Spiritual Slumber

If we lose the strength of the Lord, the anointing, or don't feel the anointing anymore, it's an alarm to:

- Arise and remember the reality of the true atmosphere hidden in Christ.
- Go back to where we have fallen and stand up again.
- Come back to our first love and cry out for His righteousness.

The Example of Samson

- Samson lost the anointing, strength, and sight, but he didn't lose the words of the Lord.
- He knew where to go for restoration (the Lord) and cried out for help.
- His hair (symbolizing the anointing) grew back, and he regained his strength.

The Promise for the Bride of Christ

- We have the promise sealed and the secret is in the “hair” of the bride (the church).
- Our spiritual “hair” is precious and can be nourished by the vitamins of the Word of God.
- When our spiritual “hair” is nourished, it will grow again and regain its strength.

The Benefits of the Anointing

- The anointing gives us the ability to be covered by His presence.
- Every yoke of bondage is broken.
- Every burden is set loose.

- Every weight upon us seems as nothing.
- The anointing changes the atmosphere, making it light and easy to escape the enemy's traps.

The Transformation of the Anointing

- The prophet Isaiah tells us that the anointing will destroy the yoke of bondage (Isaiah 10:27).
- The burden will be taken away because of the anointing.
- Our tone, mood, and countenance will be lifted.
- We will be able to see and behold Christ.

The Change in Perception

- The Lord will make our eyes pure and light, and the whole body will become light.
- We will have the eye of the dove to see how God sees.
- Only when we are walking in the Spirit can we perceive these things.

The Presence of God

- When the presence of God comes in, there is a change in the atmosphere.
- When the divine wind blows, all our senses become captivated in the realm of His Spirit.
- Where His Spirit is, there is liberty, truth, love, joy, peace, and righteousness.

The Fruits of the Spirit

- The fruit of the Spirit will be evident before our eyes.
- All the heaviness will seem as nothing.
- The atmosphere will give us a sweet rest and renew our strength.
- We will be filled with love and lose all guilt and shame.

The Fruit of Love

- Whatever does not please the Spirit will not remain in the realm of the Spirit.
- The fruit of love is what will surely remain.
- The fruit of His Spirit cannot be seen or touched unless the Lord opens our eyes.

Opening Our Eyes to the Deep Things of God

- We must cry out to the Lord to “*open our eyes to behold wondrous things out of [His] law*” (Psalm 119:18).
- If He does not open our eyes, we will remain blind and miss the spirit of the word.

The Change in Atmosphere

When the Lord opens our eyes, there will be a change in the atmosphere.

We will see:

- The reality of God's word
- Angels coming up and down upon the Son of Man

The Example of Elisha's Servant

- In 2 Kings 6:15-17, Elisha's servant saw the enemy surrounding them and panicked.
- Elisha reassured him, saying, “Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.”

The Change in Atmosphere

- When God opens our eyes to see the unseen, the atmosphere changes.
- Fear is cast out, and perfect love is set before our eyes.
- We are filled with confidence, assurance, and a new atmosphere.

The Importance of Faith

- We cannot see, touch, eat, or taste anything if God does not open our eyes.
- Let us believe in the unseen and invisible God, who is made visible through Christ Jesus.
