God's Creation

- *"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."* (John 1:1, KJV)
- *"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth."* (Genesis 1:1, KJV)
- God, who has no beginning, existed before creation began.
- God planned both the supernatural and natural aspects of creation, making Him perfect.
- As a perfect being, God's work cannot be improved upon.

God's Communication with Man

- Faith is a powerful sense that influences our imagination.
- When reflecting on the past or thinking about the future, we are using our spiritual sense.

The Curse on the World

- *"For dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return."* (Genesis 3:19, KJV)
- This scripture passage shows the curse that resulted from Adam and Eve's disobedience.
- Thorns and thistles are a curse on the world.
- When God created the world, He planted both good and bad seeds in the earth.

The Parable of the Wheat and the Weeds

- Jesus told a parable about wheat and weeds growing together.
- When the disciples asked why weeds were present, Jesus explained that the enemy was responsible.
- The enemy refers to humanity's fallen nature.
